







#### Your Career in Farming and Agriculture

#### Trade Academy Agriculture Levels 2 and 3

Trades Academy programmes are for current secondary school students, who study one or two days a week over three or four terms and gain credits towards NCEA. The learning takes place on our farm, and is practical and hands-on, using industry standard equipment and technology relevant to the agriculture sector. Students develop the foundation skills needed to progress to further study, or move directly into employment.

#### Farm Skills Level 2

Get into the great outdoors and learn the basics about agriculture on our real-life farm. From learning to ride a motorbike to animal welfare, and everything in between, this course has it all. Don't worry if you don't have any qualifications, all you need is the desire to get started. Farm Skills provides practical experience that can lead to jobs in the agriculture sector and gives you the foundations to progress to level 3 courses in Milk Harvesting, Vehicles, Machinery & Infrastructure or Farming System Technology.

#### Vehicles, Machinery and Infrastructure Level 3

Learn how to drive all sorts of farm vehicles on all sorts of terrain. Learn the art of a good fence. Clear the path with the correct use of a chainsaw. Know how to keep safe when you're out the back of the farm. This course gets you work ready to pathway on to level 3 Milk Harvesting or Farming Systems Technology or into employment.

# Farming Systems Technology Level 3

### Choose sheep and beef, or dairy

Farming Systems cover the uses of technology for land, water and herd management. The learning takes place on our farm and designed to take you to the next level in your agricultural career. If you're already working on a farm, this can be used for the work experience component. This course gets you work ready and leads on to the Level 5 Rural Animal Technology programme.

## Milk Harvesting Level 3

To produce quality milk means maintaining a quality process for milking the herd. This programme teaches you how to get the stock to the sheds, harvest the milk, keep the plant in tip top condition, understand quality control and manage effluent. This programme takes you to the next level and you'll be placed out on local farms two or three days a week getting the experience where it counts.
